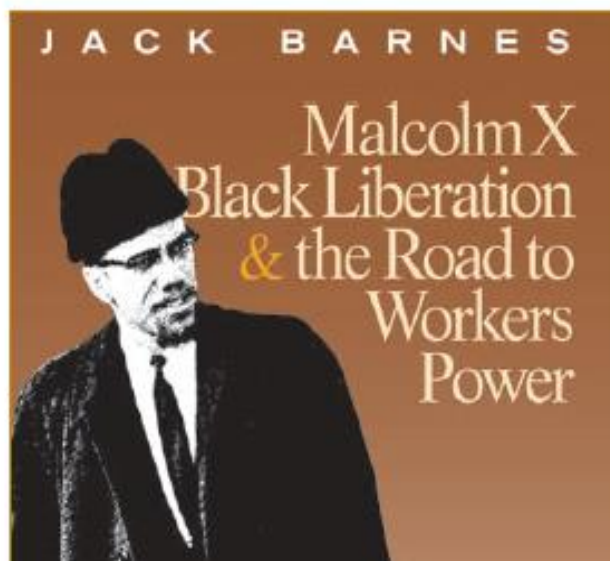
Chapter in Malcolm X, Black Liberation & the Road to Workers Power
